

EMERGENCY ACCESS ROUTE

Emergency Vehicle Access Point:

Two drop posts are in front of the vehicle gate as you enter Mount Noddy Recreation Ground from the car park, at access point 1.

To drop the access posts:

1. Collect the (S104A) key from the Ashurst Wood matchday coach.



2. Insert the key into the padlock located at the base of the post.



- 3. Turn the key clockwise, open the padlock and completely remove it.
- **4.** Using the side of your foot, push the padlock eye at the base towards the post, whilst at the same allowing the post to drop into the ground.




Repeat steps 2-4 to drop the other post.


